

**MINUTES**  
Town of North  
March 9, 2009  
North Town Hall

Mayor Jeffcoat called the regular meeting of Council to order at 6:00 p.m. and declared a quorum. Present were Council members Drew, Binyard, Lane and Gleaton. Also in attendance were Mark Fallaw, Chief of Police, and Carrie Windham, Town Clerk.

Mayor Jeffcoat led council and visitors in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Jeffcoat welcomed visitors.

Councilman Gleaton made a motion to approve the minutes from the February 9, 2009 meeting, seconded by Councilwoman Binyard, and upon vote minutes were approved.

Mayor Jeffcoat made a motion to amend the agenda to provide for an additional executive session wherein Sandy Sigmon will address Council regarding a contractual issue. The motion was seconded and passes and agenda was thereby amended.

Water/Sewer Report:

Mr. Jeffcoat presented the water / sewer report for February, 2009 (copy attached). Jeffcoat also read a summary of the Town's Sanitary Survey written by DHEC, stating that the "effort and pride associated with the operation of this system is absolutely outstanding." And "Thank Dale Weatherford for his dedication to the system and for his assistance in conducting the sanitary survey."

Police Report:

Chief Fallaw reviewed the North Police report (copy attached).

Chief Fallaw addressed the concern of a citizen regarding three dogs who are following the garbage truck, one of which attacked her small dog in her yard. Chief clarified the Town ordinance and progress of this specific case.

Street Scape Report:

Jamie Steele updated Council on the status of the project. Since the paving is complete, we hope to have enough warm weather to schedule the brick/stamping in the next week. The project is 88% complete as per the construction contract. Mr. Steele noted that Council needs to consider a barrier on the rail road property and that if Council wants to incorporate a sign now is the time to do so.

Old Business:

- o Jeffcoat reviewed the financial statement for February, 2009.
- o Councilman Drew gave an update on the playground. He is trying to contact a company that will assist an organization in the design of a recreation area.

New Business:

- o Jeffcoat discussed that the Community of Character Trait for March is Sportsmanship.
- o Council was presented with a resolution regarding compliance with FACTA Red Flag plan. Council will review the plan and discuss at next meeting.

Mayor's Report:

- Jeffcoat advised Council that the State of South Carolina is looking at approving budget cuts that would cut \$11,403 in aid to the Town of North.

Public Comments:

- A citizen commented that it would be nice to have an updated book on the Town of North.

Councilman Gleaton made a motion to adjourn into executive session, motion was seconded and Council adjourned into Executive Session at 6:40 p.m. regarding a contractual issue and a legal issue.

Regular meeting of council was reconvened at 7:10 p.m.

There being no further business, Councilwoman Lane made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded and meeting was adjourned at 7:11 p.m.
