

MINUTES

Mayor Jeffcoat called the regular meeting of Council to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were Council members Jones, Carson, Lane and Washington. Also in attendance were Chief Mark Fallaw and Town Clerk Carrie Garrett.

Mayor Jeffcoat led Council and visitors in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Jeffcoat declared a quorum and welcomed visitors.

Council member Jones made a motion to approve the minutes from the July 14, 2014 regular meeting. Motion was seconded by Council member Washington, and upon vote minutes were approved unanimously.

Public Comments:

Water/Sewer Report:

Rick Bryan presented the Water/Sewer report for July, 2014 (copy attached). By way of update, the contract with Bull Swamp Rural Water System was presented for preliminary approval, but an error was found and has been sent for revisions again. Bryan hopes to present it to Council next month.

Police Report:

Chief Fallaw reviewed the North Police report for July, 2014 (copy attached).

Old Business:

- Jeffcoat reviewed the financial statement for July, 2014.

New Business:

- Community of Character Trait for July is Respect.
- Jeffcoat opened discussion regarding implementation of Planning/Zoning fees. There were no objections to the proposed fees, a proposed ordinance will be presented at the next regular Council Meeting. Council member Carson raised a question regarding the procedures for raising rates via ordinance.

Mayor's Report:

- Mayor Jeffcoat noted that the annual Alzheimer's Bike Ride came through North on July 19th. Approximately 208 riders stopped in North for their break and raised approximately \$70,000.

Council Announcements:

- Council member Washington noted that on August 20th, Golden State Foods will present backpacks and school supplies to all first graders at Dover Elementary. He would like to begin collecting school supplies early next year to pass out at next year's National Night Out which should be held in August.

Public Comments:
